observations.	<b>Explain</b> to students that families who have a loved one that has died while they are on <u>active duty</u> in the military, or who die as a result of that service or are missing in action are called Gold Star Families. Memorial Day is a day to honor and remember veterans who have died. Memorial Day is celebrated on the last Monday in May. On Memorial Day, many Gold Star Families go to the cemetery where their loved ones are buried, to place flowers or flags, just like they did on Remembrance Day in 1865.


